"GOD WITHIN MEANS WE WIN"

"Now unto Him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us." (Eph. 3:20)

In this verse of Scripture we see that God's capabilities far exceed our greatest dreams and expectations. I believe that the greatest miracles and the most glorious acts of God recorded in the Bible are but a taste of His mighty power. These things were written, according to Romans 15:3, for our learning. God wants us acquainted with not only what He is capable of doing, but His willingness to do.

The Message translation puts it this way:

"God can do anything, you know -- far more than you could ever imagine or guess or request in your wildest dreams! He does it not by pushing us around but by working within us, His Spirit deeply and gently within us." (Eph. 3:20)

God's power exceeds our imagination. God's willingness is just as great.

There was a leper who came to Jesus, fell on his face, and said, "Jesus I know you can heal me, if you want to". Jesus responded by touching him and said, "I want to, be clean". (Luke 5:12-13) This is so simple and yet profound. God wants to so much that He is willing to do for you beyond your ability to comprehend. He is not afraid to touch you. Our mixed-up, complicated lives do not repulse Him; for God is the master at uncomplicating things. Look what He did in the beginning in Genesis. The problem is we view God through the eyes of our confusion. God is not confused. Our own fears, worries, appetites, passions, desires, along with everyone's opinion, puts us in a tug-of-war with our feelings. Jesus can and wants to bring priority to our lives, setting us at ease.

In Ephesians 3:20, we can see that His ability is released to work first within us, and then for us. This is why God so desires for you to intimately fellowship Him. For in this place of fellowship His Spirit begins to stir in you and His Word is placed deep into your heart. This is where the life of God is discovered. Out of that intimacy, the ability of God rises within us and we become mighty weapons in the hand of God. Without this fellowship with God, we are most hopeless.

The simple reality is that God loves us so much that He vigorously desires to touch our lives with His unlimited power. Let go of your fears and let God work within.
