(BORN AGAIN - NEW BIRTH)

I. TO SEE THE KINGDOM OF GOD John 3:1-21 "...Except a man be <u>born</u> <u>again</u>, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

A. DEFINITIONS

- 1. Salvation-
 - (American Dictionary of the English Language Noah Webster) a. the act of <u>saving</u>;
 - b. preservation from <u>destruction</u>, danger or great calamity.
- 2. Born Again-
 - (Strong's Hebrews and Greek Dictionary)
 - a. to be regenerated and <u>**renewed**</u>; b. be delivered of.

II. HOW SIN ENTERED IN

- A. In The Beginning
 - 1. Genesis 1:27
- 2. Genesis 2:15 "And the Lord God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to <u>dress</u> it and to <u>keep</u> it."

B. The First Command

- 1. Genesis 2:16-17 "....But of the tree of the <u>knowledge</u> of good and evil, thou shalt <u>not</u> eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely <u>die</u>.

- Genesis 3:6-7 "...she took of the fruit thereof, and <u>did</u> eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.

 - a. <u>Neglect</u> or <u>refusal</u> to obey;
 - b. violation of a command or prohibition;

- c. The omission of that which is <u>commanded</u> to be done, or the doing of that which is forbid;
 - d. breach of duty prescribed by authority.
 - 2. Offense
- (Thorndike Barnhart Comprehensive Dictionary)
- a. a <u>breaking</u> of the law, <u>sin</u>: (an offense against God and man)
- b. cause of wrongdoing.
- c. condition of being offended; hurt feelings, anger.

D. <u>Debt</u> now <u>owed</u>

1. Romans 6:23a "For the <u>wages</u> of sin is death;..." (The Death Of Just Anyone <u>Would</u> <u>Not</u> Do!)

E. Can't <u>save</u> yourself

 Ephesians 2: 8-9 "For by grace are ye saved....., and that not of <u>yourselves</u>.... Not of <u>works</u>, lest any man should boast.

a. Obedience -

(American Dictionary of the English Language -

- Noah Webster)
 - 1. Compliance with a command, prohibition or known law and rule of duty prescribed
 - 2. the performance of what is required or enjoyed by authority

(To constitute <u>obedience</u>, the act or

forbearance to act <u>must</u> <u>be</u> in

submission to authority.)

Matthew 26:39b "...nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt."

Romans 5:19 "...so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous." Hebrews 12:1

D. Jesus' <u>blood</u>

 <u>Remission</u> - Forgiveness; pardon, that is the giving up of the punishment due to a crime, as the remission of sins.

a. Hebrews 9:22 "...and without <u>shedding</u> of blood is no remission.

- b. Matthew 26:28
- c. Mark 14:24
- d. Luke 22:20 "This cup is the new testament in My blood, which is shed for you.
- 2. <u>**Purchased**</u> Obtained or acquired by one's <u>**own**</u> act or agreement.
 - a. Acts 20:28b "...to feed the church of God, which He hath purchased with His own blood.
- 3. <u>**Redeemed**</u> /Redemption Ransomed: delivered from <u>**bondage**</u>, distress, penalty, liability, or from the possession of another, by paying an equivalent.
 - a. Ephesians 1:7
 - b. Colossians 1:4 "In whom we have redemption through His blood, even the <u>forgiveness</u> of sins:"

- c. Hebrews 9:12-22 "Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by His <u>own</u> blood He entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us."
- d. I Peter 1:18-19 "…redeemed…with the _______ of Christ."
- c. Revelation 5:9b "...for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by Thy blood..."

V. HOW YOU ARE BORN AGAIN

- A. Receive Jesus
 - 1. John 1:12 "But as many as <u>**received**</u> Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God,..."
- B. By Grace Through Faith
 - Romans 5:15-21 "...That as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might grace reign through <u>righteousness</u> unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord."
 - 2. Ephesians 2:5, 8 "For by grace are ye saved through faith;..."
- C. Believe 1. Romans 10:9-10
- D. Confess

1. Romans 10:9-10
