I. DEFINED:

A. GIFT - Charisma (Greek) - a (divine) <u>gratuity</u>; (spec.) a

(spiritual) endowment; (obj.) miraculous <u>faculty</u>.

	Greek Lexicon: extraordinary powers , distinguishing
certain	Christians and enabling them to
<u>serve</u>	the
power of	church of Christ, the reception of which is due to the
	divine grace operating in their souls by the Holy Spirit.

B. The Gifts of the Spirit are God's anointed <u>empowerments</u>.

C. These anointed endowments must be treated with holy <u>respect</u>.

D. There is no <u>empowerment</u> without accountability.

E. Once God has <u>endowed</u>, the gift is

<u>irrevocable</u>. (Rom. 11:29)

F. The laws of God's grace that gave us these gifts also make us

<u>accountable</u> with no excuses.

II. <u>MOTIVATIONAL</u> GIFTS:

A. These gifts are found in Rom. 12:4-8.

B. These are gifts that determine the different <u>ways</u> in which

we are <u>motivated</u> and <u>how</u> God uses them to

1. Prophecy - discourse emanating from divine _____inspiration_____

Characteristics:

delay.

- e. Have physical <u>stamina</u>, which may disregard

weariness.

- f. Enjoy <u>short</u>-term goals.
- g. Complete jobs with <u>extra</u> service.
- 3. Teaching to impart <u>instruction</u>; instill <u>doctrine</u> into one.

Characteristics:

- a. They believe that their gift is <u>foundational</u>.

- A. The nine Gifts of the Spirit are God-<u>abilities</u> released through the body.
- B. These gifts are found in I Cor. 12. They are divided into three categories:

<u>Revelation</u>, <u>Power</u> and <u>Inspiration</u>.

- 1. Revelation Gifts:
 - a. <u>Word</u> <u>of</u> <u>Knowledge</u>: the <u>revealing</u> or <u>exposing</u> of a <u>fact</u> in existence which cannot be seen or heard or revealed naturally.
 - b. <u>Word</u> <u>of</u> <u>Wisdom</u>: the revealing of the

prophetic <u>future</u> under the anointing of God;

The <u>Interpretation</u> of <u>Tongues</u> : when, without any **mental** faculties, the message that has been given in another **language** is **interpreted** supernaturally by the Spirit. c. The Gift of **Prophecy** : the anointed speaking forth of words of **edification**, exhortation and **comfort** to the church supernaturally given from God without human meditation.

d. NOTE: The gifts are <u>vocal</u> in nature. These <u>vocal</u> gifts may be used to <u>verbally</u>

express

one of the <u>revelation</u> or <u>power</u> gifts.
