- I. **EVERYTHING BELONGS TO GOD:**
 - A. Haggai 2:8 -- Silver and gold.
 - B. Leviticus 27:30 -- The tithe.
 - C. Hebrews 1:2 -- Jesus, heir of all things.

II. THE TITHE:

- A. Genesis 28:22b ...and of <u>all</u> that thou shalt give me I will surely give the <u>tenth</u> unto thee.
- B. Deuteronomy 14:22
 - 1. Tithe is 10%.
 - a. The <u>first</u> tenth of your increase.
 - b. To be from the gross and not the net.
- C. Leviticus 27:30,34a (vs 30) And all the <u>tithe</u> of the land, whether of the seed of the land, or of the fruit of the tree, is the <u>Lord's</u>: it is <u>holy</u> unto the Lord. (vs 34a)These are the <u>commandments</u>, which the Lord <u>commanded</u>
 Moses...
 - 1. The tithe is Holy.
 - 2. It belongs to God.
 - 3. It is a commandment of God.

III. TITHING THE TITHE:

A. Deuteronomy Chapter 26

- B. Malachi 3:8-14
- C. Ministers are <u>commanded</u> to <u>receive</u> the tithe:
 - Heb. 7:5a And verily they that are of the sons of Levi, who receive the <u>office</u> of the <u>priesthood</u>, have a <u>commandment</u> to <u>take</u> tithes of the people...
- 2. Heb. 7:8 (AMP) Furthermore, here [in the Levitical priesthood]

tithes are <u>received</u> by men who are subject to death; while there [in the case of Melchizedek], they are

received by

one of whom it is testified that he lives [perpetually].

- D. Bring the tithe:
 - 1. Malachi 3:9-10
 - a. Blessed when you do.
 - b. Cursed when you don't.

E. Tithe First:

- I Corinthians 16:2a Upon the <u>first</u> <u>day</u> of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, as God hath prospered him,...
 - a. It should be given first place (priority).
 - b. So it won't be spent.
 - c. It will <u>cost</u> you if you don't tithe. An <u>additional</u> amount (20%) will be added to it.

Lev. 27:31 And if a man will at all redeem ought of his tithes, he shall <u>add</u> thereto the <u>fifth</u> part thereof.

F. By <u>faith</u>:

- 1. Genesis 4:3-8 Hebrews 11:4, 6
 - a. Respected (regarded) if by faith.

b. Not respected (regarded) if not by faith.

G. From your <u>heart</u>:

1. Deuteronomy 26:16

Luke 11:42

Malachi 3:13-14

- a. Whole heart and soul.
- b. In love.
- c. Without grudging, murmuring, or complaining.

H. Worship and Rejoice:

- 1. Deuteronomy 26:10b, 11a
 - a. Worship the Lord.
 - b. Rejoice in the Lord.

IV. BENEFITS OF TITHING:

- A. Malachi 3:9-12
 - 1. Meat in God's house:
 - a. It's the ministry inheritance.
 - b. There should be $\underline{\text{meat}}$ where we come together and

eat.

- 2. Prove God:
 - a. He opens the windows of heaven.
 - b. He <u>pours</u> out a blessing. (More Than Enough)
- 3. Protection:
 - a. The devourer is rebuked.
 - b. Our fruit is not destroyed.
 - c. Nor will our fruit produce fruit before its time.
- 4. Blesssed:
 - a. All nations will call us blessed.
 - b. A <u>delightsome</u> land.

V. **EXAMPLES** OF TITHES:

- A. Genesis 28:22b ...and of all that thou shalt give me (Jacob) I will surely give the <u>tenth</u> unto Thee.
- B. Deuteronomy 14:22 Thou shalt truly tithe all the <u>increase</u> of thy seed, that the field bringeth forth year by year.
- C. Deuteronomy 26
- D. II Chronicles 31:5
- E. II Chronicles 31:12a
- F. Nehemiah 13:12 Then brought all Judah the <u>tithe</u> of the corn and the new wine and the oil unto the treasuries.
- G. Proverbs 3:9-10
- H. Luke 11:42 But woe unto you, Pharisees! for ye tithe mint and rue and all manner of herbs, and pass over judgment and the love of God: these <u>ought</u> ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

VI. OFFERINGS:

- A. You have not given an <u>offering</u> until you have <u>tithed</u>.

 Malachi 3:8 Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed Me.

 But ye say, Wherein have we <u>robbed</u> Thee? In tithes and offerings.
- B. Giving:

You have to GIVE before you can RECEIVE.

1. Luke 6:38

- a. Men will give to you.
- b. It will come back running over.
- c. How you give will be how you get it back.
- 2. Acts 20:35
 - a. More <u>blessed</u> to give than to receive.
- C. <u>Sowing</u> (<u>Seeding</u>, <u>Planting</u>):

You have to <u>SOW</u> before you can <u>REAP</u>.

- 1. Galatians 6:7 Be not <u>deceived</u>; God is not mocked: for <u>whatsoever</u> a man <u>soweth</u>, that shall he also reap.
- 2. II Corinthians 9:6, 10
 - a. Sow sparingly reap sparingly.
 - b. Sow bountifully reap bountifully.
- D. Casting:

You have to <u>CAST</u> your bread before you can <u>FIND</u> it.

- 1. Ecclesiastes 11:1 <u>Cast</u> thy bread upon the waters: for thou shalt <u>find</u> it after many days.
 - a. If no casting then,
 - b. No finding.
- E. From your heart:
 - 1. By <u>faith</u>.

Hebrews 11:6

- 2. Joyful:
 - II Corinthians 9:6-7
 - a. Not grudgingly.
 - b. Not of necessity.
 - c. Cheerful (joyous, "prompt to do it") (Amplified).
- 3. In <u>Jesus</u> and in <u>love</u>:

Colossians 3:17

I John 3:17-18

a. Do it in the <u>name</u> of the <u>Lord</u>.

b. Do it in love.

VII. <u>ALMS</u>:

Alms is giving to the poor.

- A. Lend to the Lord:
 - 1. Proverbs 19:17
 - a. You lend to the Lord.
 - b. He <u>repays</u> you.
- B. Rewards:
 - 1. Matthew 6:1, 4
 - a. To be done in <u>secret</u>.
 - b. He will reward openly.
- C. God remembers:

Acts 10:2, 4

- 1. He feared God.
- 2. He gave much alms.
- 3. His alms were a memorial before God.
- 4. He received salvation.

VIII. THE LORD HAS PLEASURE IN OUR PROSPERITY:

A. Psa. 35:27 Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour My righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the

Lord be

magnified, which hath <u>pleasure</u> in the <u>prosperity</u> of his servant.
