### I. DEFINITION:

# A. What faith is:

1. (According to the Vine's Dictionary) - primarily, firm, persuasion; a

conviction based upon <u>hearing</u> (to persuade); is used in the N.T. always of faith in God or Christ, or things spiritual.

 (According to Scripture) - Hebrews 11:1
(KJV) "Now faith is the <u>SUBSTANCE</u> of things hoped for, the <u>EVIDENCE</u> of things not seen."

(AMPLIFIED) "Now faith is the <u>assurance</u> (the confirmation, the title deed) of the things [we] hope for, being the <u>proof</u> of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving <u>as</u> real <u>fact</u> what is not revealed to the senses].

- B. You have to have <u>hope</u> before you can use your <u>faith</u>.
- C. Faith, however, is not <u>hope</u>. Faith is laying <u>hold</u> of the unrealities of hope and bringing them into the realm of <u>reality</u> by acting on the <u>Word</u>.
- D. If you are not <u>hoping</u> for something, then there would be no use of faith.
- E. You can have hope and not have <u>faith</u>, but you cannot have faith <u>without</u> hope.
- F. Faith is like a thermostat.
  - 1. You <u>want</u> or <u>desire</u> a certain temperature of 70 degrees.

- 2. <u>Hope</u> is your want/desire for 70 degrees.
- 3. Wanting (hoping) will not get the temperature to 70.
- 4. You must <u>turn</u> (action word -- you take action <u>now</u>) the thermostat to 70 degrees.
- 5. Your faith is now in knowing that the temperature will be 70.
- 6. When you turn the thermostat to 70 degrees the temperature doesn't become 70 degrees automatically; but, as the

## thermostat

kicks in, it's just a matter of time that it will be 70 degrees.

- G. This is exactly <u>how</u> faith works.
  - 1. You hope for something.
  - 2. Your faith acts NOW!
  - 3. Faith is an action word.
  - 4. You have no <u>doubt!</u>
  - 5. You know it will happen, even when the circumstance does not immediately <u>change</u>.
  - 6. Your faith says it <u>already</u> has happened (even though the manifestation has not yet happened).
    - 1. As in the thermostat example: You had <u>no fear</u> that it

## would

be 70 degrees.

- H. Faith is NOW! (Heb. 11:1a "Now faith is...)
  - 1. If it isn't now, then it isn't faith.
- I. Faith is <u>not</u> just <u>believing</u>.
  - 1. Believing is what you behold to be true.
  - 2. You can believe a lie; it is a spiritual substance.
  - 3. You <u>must</u> believe what the <u>Word</u> (Bible) says -- believing what <u>God</u> says!
- J. Faith is a <u>force</u>, but you cannot force <u>faith!</u>

### II. ORIGINATOR OF FAITH:

- A. Who originated faith:
  - 1. <u>God</u> originated faith.
- a. Hebrews 11:3 "Through faith we understand that the worlds were

framed by the word of God..."

- B. Who gives and develops faith:
  - 1. <u>God</u> starts everyone out with the <u>same</u> measure of faith.
    - a. Romans 12:3b "...but to think soberly, according as God

hath

dealt to every man the measure of faith."

- 2. <u>Jesus</u> is the developer of our faith.
  - a. Hebrews 12:2 "Looking unto Jesus the author and

<u>finisher</u>

of our faith;..."

## III. HOW FAITH COMES:

- A. God's part:
  - 1. God gives to every man the measure of faith.
    - a. Romans 12:3b
- B. <u>Our</u> part:
  - 1. We must <u>hear</u>, <u>speak</u>, and <u>study</u> the Word!
  - 2. In <u>hearing</u> the Word, not just once having heard it, but a <u>continuance</u> of hearing it.
    - a. Romans 10:17 "Faith comes by hearing and hearing by

the

Word...:"

- 3. In <u>speaking</u> the Word, don't let negative circumstances come in and <u>drown</u> out what the Word says.
- a. Prov. 18:7 "A fool's <u>mouth</u> is his destruction, and his <u>lips</u>

are the snare of his soul (mind, will, and emotions).

- b. Prov. 18:21 "Death and life are in the power of the tongue:.."
- 4. In studying the Word, study to know what is rightfully yours.
  - a. II Tim. 2:15 "Study to show thyself approved..."
  - b. II Peter 1:1-10
  - 5. You must believe those things which you <u>say</u> will come to pass.
  - 6. Your entire vocabulary must be <u>disciplined</u>.
  - 7. Your faith will not work above the <u>level</u> of your confession.

## IV. WHERE FAITH IS FOUND:

- A. Faith is found in your <u>heart</u> and in your <u>mouth.</u>
  - 1. Romans 10:8 "...in thy mouth and in thy heart..."
- B. Faith is in your mouth and heart, not your head.
- C. Your <u>head</u> (carnal thoughts, the way you think) trys to <u>reason</u> things out of faith, filling you full of <u>doubt</u> and <u>unbelief</u>.

### V. WHY WE LIVE BY FAITH:

- A. Living by faith PLEASES God!
- 1. Hebrews 11:6a "But without faith it is impossible to please Him,..."
  - B. God is not going to do anything that is outside of His <u>character</u>. (If it doesn't please Him, then it would be outside of His character.)

### VI. WORKS OF FAITH

- A. Faith works by love:
  - 1. Gal. 5:6b "...but faith worketh by love."

- B. Works (actions) of faith:
  - 1. Talks/Speaks.
    - a. Romans 10:6 "which is of faith speaketh on this wise"
    - b. Mark 11:22-23 (speaks to mountains)
    - c. Romans 4:17b "...<u>calleth</u> those things which be not as

though

they were."

- d. There is a difference between <u>talking</u> <u>faith</u> and faith talking:
  - 1. Anyone can talk it (mouth off).
  - 2. But, when faith talks, it is not mere "mouthing off",

but it's

the mountain moving power being spoken.

- 2. Is <u>alive!</u>
  - a. Works (actions) show that faith is alive.
  - b. James 2:14-26 (vs. 20) "But wilt thou know, O vain man,

that faith

without works is <u>dead</u>?"

## VII. BENEFITS OF FAITH:

- A. <u>Saves</u>
  - a. Ephesians 2:5, 8 ("saved by grace through faith")
- B. <u>Heals</u>
  - a. James 5:15 ("and the prayer of faith shall save the sick...")
- C. Delivers

## VIII. FAITH IS SEEN AND AFFECTS OTHERS TO ACT:

A. Matthew 9:20-22 ("...touched the hem of His garment....Daughter, be

of

His

good comfort,: thy faith hath made thee whole.")

- 1. The people surrounding them <u>saw</u> what happened.
- B. Matthew 14:34-36 ("...when the men of that place had knowledge of Him,...they be sought Him that they might only touch the hem of

garment..."

1. Because they saw and had <u>knowledge</u> of what had happened when the woman with the issue of blood touched His

garment, they

also sought to do the same.

- C. Good <u>reports</u> of faith. (Read Hebrews chapter 11)
  - 1. Hebrews 11:2 "For by it the elders obtained a good report."
