BENEFITS OF THE NEW COVENANT

I. QUALIFING FOR THE BENEFITS:

A. God's <u>will</u> is that you be <u>blessed</u> in all areas of your

<u>life</u>.

- 1. III John 2 (prosper and be in health as your soul prospers)
- 2. Gal. 3:13-14
- B. Man takes on the nature of sin through the
 - <u>fall</u> of Adam.
 - 1. Gen. 2:16-17
 - 2. Gen. 3:1-11
- C. <u>Sin</u> carries with it the <u>curse</u> of sin -- the <u>cutting</u> off of life. 1. Gen. 3:12-24
- D. The Abrahamic Covenant establishes God's <u>will</u> to <u>bless</u> man by believing on Him.
 - 1. Gal. 3:6 Even as Abraham <u>believed</u> God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.
 - 2. Gen. 15:6 And he believed in the Lord; and He counted it to him for righteousness.
 - 3. Rom. 4:3,8-9
 - 4. Gal.4:22-29
- E. The Mosaic Covenant <u>shows</u> our <u>need</u> to be <u>justified</u> by faith in Jesus Christ.
 - 1. Gal. 4:22-29
- F. The New Covenant establishes justification through <u>faith</u> in Jesus Christ.
 - 1. Gal. 3:8
 - 2. Rom. 4:3,22
 - 3. Rom. 5:2

- II. THE BENEFITS:
 - A. Jesus Christ has <u>redeemed</u> us from the curse of the law. (Gal. 3:13) (Deut. 28:15-68
 - 1. <u>Poverty</u>,
 - 2. <u>Sickness</u>,
 - 3. Spiritual Death.
 - B. Jesus took our curse that the <u>blessing</u> of Abraham might come on us. (Gal. 3:14)
 - 1. Prosperity
 - 2. Health
 - 3. Spiritual Life
 - (Deut. 28:1-14)
- III. PROSPERITY:
 - A. Prosperity <u>well</u> being, <u>peace</u>, <u>advance</u> welfare, <u>doing</u> well, profit.
 - B. Prosper in <u>all</u> that you do.
 - 1. Deut. 29:9 2. Psa. 1:3
 - C. Prosper <u>where</u> ever you <u>go</u>. 1. Joshua 1:7
 - D. <u>Pray</u> that you prosper. 1. III John 2
 - E. The Lord teaches us to profit.
 - F. Preach the <u>Gospel</u> (Good News) to the <u>poor</u>. 1. Luke 4:18
 - (NOTE: There are many other Scriptures.)

IV. HEALTH AND HEALING (DEUT. 28:1-14):

- A. Health be well, <u>wholesome</u>, sound.
 - Healing <u>medicine</u>, cure, to make <u>whole</u>, to <u>restore</u> to health.
- B. Old Covenant Scriptures:
 - 1. Exod. 15:26 I am the Lord that healeth thee.
 - 2. Psa. 107:20 He sent His Word and healed them.
 - 3. Isa. 53:5b By His stripes we are healed.
 - 4. Psa. 103:2-3 Forget not all His <u>benefits</u>, who forgiveth <u>all</u> thine iniquities, who <u>healeth</u> <u>all</u> thy <u>diseases</u>.

(NOTE: These are only a few Scriptures. There are numerous others.)

- C. New Testament Scriptures:
 - 1. I Pet. 2:24b By Whose stripes ye were healed.
 - 2. Matt. 4:23 Went about healing <u>all</u> manner of <u>sickness</u> and <u>disease</u>.
 - 3. Acts 10:38 ...God <u>anointed</u> Jesus with the Holy Ghost and with power who went about <u>healing</u> all that were <u>oppressed</u> of the <u>devil</u>.
 - 4. Matt. 8:16 He cast out devils with His <u>Word</u>, and <u>healed</u> all that were sick.

5. Luke 5:17b The <u>power</u> of the Lord was present to <u>heal</u> them.

(NOTE: There are many more Scripture references. Jesus is still healing today -- for He is the <u>same</u> yesterday, today and forever. Heb. 13:8)

- V. SPIRITUAL LIFE:
 - A. Life The state of one who is possessed of vitality. <u>Absolute</u> fulness of life, both essential and ethical, which belongs to God. The <u>God</u>-kind of life (<u>spirit</u> life).
 - B. John 3:16 Whosoever believeth on Him (Jesus) shall have everlasting life.
 - C. John 5:24 He that heareth His Word and believeth is passed from <u>death</u> unto <u>life</u>.
 - D. John 6:35 Jesus is the <u>bread</u> of life.
 - E. John 10:10 I am come that they might have <u>life</u> and have it more <u>abundantly</u>.
 - F. Rom. 6:23 The gift of God is <u>eternal</u> life.
 - G. Rom. 8:2 The spirit <u>life</u> in Christ Jesus has <u>freed</u> us from the law of <u>sin</u> and death.
 - H. Rom. 8:6 To be <u>spiritually</u> minded is <u>life</u>.
 - I. Rom. 8:10 Spirit is life because of righteousness in Christ Jesus.

(NOTE: The New Covenant through Christ Jesus has made our spirits alive to God.

VI. CONCLUSION:

- A. Our justification (<u>qualification</u>) for the benefits of the New Covenant are through the righteousness (<u>right actions</u>) of Jesus Christ and <u>faith</u> in Him.
- B. All that we need in life were covered in three basic areas:
 - 1. Prosperity.
 - 2. <u>Healing</u>.
 - 3. Spiritual Life.
- C. These three areas were covered in God's <u>original commission</u> to Adam in the Garden of Eden.
