II. THE BLOOD OF THE NEW TESTAMENT:

A. Luke 22:20 ...This cup is the New Testament in
my blood, which is shed for you.

(AMPLIFIED) ...He took the cup after supper, saying, This cup
is
the New Testament or Covenant [ratified] in My blood, which is

shed (poured out) for you.

B. Mark 14:24 ...This is My blood of the New
Covenant,
which is shed for many.

C. I Cor. 10:16a The cup of blessing which we bless, is it
not the communion of the blood of Christ?...

(AMPLIFIED) The cup of blessing [of wine at the Lord's Supper]
upon which we ask [God's] blessing, does it not mean [that in
drinking it] we participate in and share a fellowship (a
communion)
in the blood of Christ (the Messiah)?...

D. The communion cup is not to be partaken of unworthily.
(I Cor. 11:23-32)

E. The New Testament blood was without sin or fault,
which makes the blood of Jesus holy and
sinless. (Heb. 9:12-14)

NOTE: This is the power of His blood.

F. God took away the first that He may establish the
second Covenant. (Heb. 10:9-10)

G. His Covenant He will not break or alter.
(Psa. 89:34-35)

H. He is always mindful of His Covenant. (Psa. 111:5)

THE BLOOD OF CHRIST

I. Jesus has become the mediator of the New Covenant. (Heb. 9:15)

1. Mediator - one who intervenes between two, either in order to make or restore peace

and

friendship, or to form a compact, or for ratifying a covenant.
