1. If you are not a part of a local church, you are in danger.
2. God is not building an audience, He is building an army.
I Corinthians 12:27 "Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular."
3. Another word for particular is me (ye). I am a special member of the body of Christ.
4. We will not get the full power or the full potential out of the church if we do not have all the special members working and functioning properly.

I Corinthians 12:28: " And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues."

5. God set the ministry of helps in the church.
6. The ministry of helps is a supernatural ministry.
7. The ministry of helps is just as valid and just as anointed as if God had asked me to be a prophet.
8. A Greek definition of *helps* is, "One of the ministrations in the local church, by way of rendering assistance, or especially of help ministered to the weak and the needy."
9. If I feel like God is not talking to me, I should check to see if I am doing what He told me to do.
10. When Christians are asked to serve in the church, this phrase seems to rise from there lips automatically:
"I don't feel led".
11. The Bible says, "Whatever your hand findeth to do, do it with all your might,"
(Eccl. 9:10)
